1. Confidence and determination to have a final , equitable and acceptable
2. International Law and UNCLOS – base. Historical and other – supplementary, consultative
3. Fishery and Maritime delimitation - settled integrated not isolated – single line
4. Offshore features should be treated in different manner with the mainland i.e. they should have a partial effect in maritime delimitation.
5. Patience and managing situation – not use of force
6. Approach comprehensive, step by step with different level of negotiation
7. JD applied in both gulfs, based on UNCLOS when the sovereign disputes have not been existed
